SUBJECT: WEST PAKISTAN DEPARTMENTAL INQUIRIES ACT 1958
(XLV OF 1958) FOR EXPEDITIOUS RESPONSE.

Sir,

I am directed to state that it has been brought to the notice of the Chief Secretary, Government of Sindh, that the Chief Minister's Inspection, Enquiries & Implementation Team, while conducting enquiries in the matters assigned to it by the Governor/Chief Minister/Chief Secretary, is facing difficulty because the officers/officials are either reluctant or deny access to the required record. Besides there are instances where officers/officials have refused to submit the relevant record/documents inspite of repeated reminders and personal contacts over telephone. This attitude on the part of officers/officials is violative of provisions of the West Pakistan Departmental Inquiries (Powers) Act 1958, which has been adopted by the Government of Sindh (copies enclosed). Moreover, it causes delay in completion of enquiries.

2. I am, therefore, directed to request you to kindly ensure that all officers/officials working in the departments/autonomous and Semi-autonomous bodies/Corporations under your administrative control shall promptly provide the documents/information to the Chief Minister's Inspection, Enquiries and Implementation Team as and when asked for the same. Besides they shall extend all possible assistance to the Team for completion of enquiry. Failure to comply with these instructions would entail action against defaulting officers/officials under E&I Rules.

3. This issues with the approval of the Chief Secretary, Sindh.
