NOTIFICATION

No. S.O. II (S&GAD)-4-22/78: In supersession of this Department's Notification of even number dated 29-11-1979, the Governor's MLA's Inspection Team is hereby re-designated as Chief Minister's Inspection and Evaluation Team which will be headed by an Officer of BS-20. The Team will comprise of following two Wings:-

(I) Technical Wing:- It will continue with existing organization having Headquarter at Hyderabad. It will continue to perform the functions and duties specified in Govt. of Sind Notification No. E&A(P&D) Estt: 6(26)/74, dated 18.09.1974. In addition, the Technical Wing will pay special attention to ensure that the short comings and deficiencies in the following fields are removed:-

- (i) In the case of construction of buildings and Public Health Engineering Works, stereo-typed plans/drawings have been adopted for the entire Province irrespective of different climatic conditions prevailing within the province.
- (ii) Uneconomical and stereo-typed designs meant for extreme soil conditions are adopted resulting in unnecessary/wasteful expenditure.
- (iii) Rich and costly specifications of finishing items are provided to cover the bad work-manship and under-specification works.
- (iv) With the exception of the national highway, all roads are constructed with stereo-typed specifications of 12 feet carriage-way, 12 inches thickness and three coats of surfacing. This is done without taking into consideration the future traffic flows and soil conditions. This results in over-spending in some cases and under-designing in others.
- (v) Estimates, particularly of Irrigation Department, relating to earthwork are exaggeratedly prepared. These estimates contain provision of earth work quantities on far higher side which are being exploited resulting in mis-appropriation of funds.
- (vi) In the tendering process proper competition is not being held and tenders are sold to favourite parties.

(II) Evaluation Wing:- It will continue with the existing organization of Governor's Inspection Team (less its Technical Wing) with Headquarter at Karachi and is assigned the following functions and duties:-

- (i) To undertake all special assignments given by the Provincial Chief Executive.
- (ii) To provide Information Management Service.
- (iii) To check the functioning of all provincial departments including P&D Department, and unbiased assessment to the Chief Executive.
- (iv) To monitor progress of federally executed works in the province and determine its impact/fall-out effects.
- (v) To conceive new Schemes and act as the "Think Tank" for the Chief Executive.

The Chief Minister of Sind has been pleased to constitute Performance Evaluation Committee for Development with the following composition:

- (1) Additional Chief Secretary (Development). Chairman.
- (2) Secretary, Finance Department. Member.

2. The Chief Minister of Sind is further pleased to set up "Chief Minister's Inspection Team For Development Projects" in the Planning and Development Department for inspection and evaluation of the performance of development projects. The Team will comprise a Director-General and a Director.

3. The duties and functions of the Inspection Team shall be as under:—

- (a) Inspecting Development Projects and appraising the physical and financial progress;
- (b) Watching the progress of individual development projects and identifying the bottlenecks through inspection and monthly as well as quarterly progress reports;
- (c) Reporting on mis-use or waste of physical and financial resources;
- (d) Making concrete recommendations to overcome the bottlenecks with a view to improving the performance and effecting both efficiency and economy.

4. In order to carry out its functions and duties, the Inspection Team shall be visiting various Development Projects, ongoing as well as completed, from time to time, with or without notice. The Team would associate the Head of the Attached Department or a Senior Officer concerned with the inspection so that the point of view of the executing agency is reflected in the report. The Team will be competent to call for and examine any document.

5. The Performance Evaluation Committee will be assisted in its work by the Chief Minister's Inspection Team. The reports of the Inspection Team will be considered by the Performance Evaluation Committee and submitted to the Chief Minister with necessary recommendations after discussion with the Secretary of the Administrative Department concerned, for perusal and orders. Quarterly reports will also be submitted to the Council of Ministers for review.

6. The Performance Evaluation Committee would critically watch and assess the performance of the Inspection Team, and would also inspect selected development projects.

7. With a view to streamlining the inspection and evaluation work, a broad out-line has been chalked out a copy of which is attached. The Inspection Team would be generally looking for the data and information on the lines indicated in the outline.

8. The Administrative Departments will issue necessary directives to the Heads of the Departments and their subordinate officers to co-operate and extend full assistance to the Inspection Team during inspection and make available to them documents, record and information required for the purposes of inspection, and to facilitate the task of the Inspection Team in carrying out a proper appraisal of the implementation of development projects.

1. The Performance Evaluation Committee, while submitting a Chief Minister/Council of Ministers will also record its observations reporting, and on the co-operation and assistance extended as concerned.
